# Here are some things to keep in mind about the weekend.

As before, please bring a **music stand**, clearly marked with your name, with you if you can. All musicians must have a **pencil**. Woodwinds, please make sure you have extra **reeds**, and any other supplies you may need for the weekend. Brass players, check your music to see if you need **mutes** and make sure that you have what you need (if you don't have your own mute, ask your band teacher). Percussionists please bring sticks. Mallets will be available but you may wish to bring your own.

# Member information:

### **Confirmation of attendance**

By now you should have confirmed your attendance for the March 23<sup>rd</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> weekend and have requested a billet if you require one. This has been taken care of by Helen Bannerman, our auditions and personnel coordinator. Please contact Helen **immediately** if there has been any change in your status (for example, if you no longer need a billet). If you cannot attend due to an unexpected emergency, we may be able to find a replacement to fill your chair, but will need adequate notice. *It is important to give proper notice, as one empty chair will affect the whole ensemble*.

### When and Where

A schedule of rehearsals and activities is at the end of this letter.

The host school is Pine Ridge Middle School and the host director is Sarah Keddy. We are meeting starting Friday, March 23 until Sunday, March 25<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Uniform**

Please remember to bring your uniform sweatshirt with you. If you come without your uniform (or are unable to find one before the concert) you will be unable to perform.

In case you forgot, the uniform for NSJWE concerts is:

- **black** dress pants or long skirt
- **black** dress shoes
- **black** socks or stockings
- **white** collared shirt
- NSJWE sweatshirt

Please make sure you arrive at the weekend with the proper clothing. We feel it's important that a group of this musical caliber present a professional image in concert.

(Just pack your uniform components in your bag; you can wear whatever is comfortable for most of the weekend rehearsals and social event.)

### **Group Photo**

On Sunday, just prior to the concert, we will take a group photo of the band in concert dress. These will be mailed to you once they are printed. Copies must be ordered and prepaid (\$25 per photo) before you leave on Sunday.

## **Billeting Students**

If you have requested a billet, you will be paired up with your host family at the end of Friday night's session. Please ensure that Helen (our personnel coordinator) is informed of any special dietary needs or pertinent medical conditions well in advance of the weekend so that we can match you with an appropriate billet. We will have a phone list available for your parents when they drop you off so they know how to reach you. Please bring a sleeping bag and a small gift for your host family.

### **Expectations**

- -You are expected to arrive at the weekend able to play your parts well. The rehearsal time will be devoted to interpreting the music, not learning parts. Remember, this is a provincial ensemble, not your school band. We have less than two days to make wonderful music happen. The ensemble is counting on you!
- -High standards of rehearsal etiquette are expected. Arrive early for each rehearsal and work hard to maintain your focus throughout the rehearsal. Remember to turn off all cell phones during rehearsals.
- -Come prepared to work hard, make new friends, learn new stuff, and have fun! You will probably be amazed by what the group will accomplish in the course of the weekend!
