# Group Performance

The NSJWE is made up of some of the best musicians of this age group in the province and we know that you are always working hard to make the best music possible. We have all missed performing with others and, assuming the restrictions do not change, we will be able to perform on the Spatz Theatre stage. We have scheduled our performance for 1:00 pm on Sunday, May 16th, 2021. Musicians should be prepared to perform ALL of this year's music at this performance. This includes the three pieces from our virtual weekend as well.

Due to current restrictions, each performer will only be permitted to bring 2 audience members. Tickets will be given to each NSJWE member on Friday evening, at registration, and we ask that you use these for entrance to the performance. We will also be collecting contact tracing information for everyone in attendance. Seating will be limited and will require social distancing between families/bubbles of at least 6 feet. A properly worn mask will be required during the entire performance for audience members, NSJWE executives, and Spatz Theatre staff.
