The Truro Concert Band is one of the town's oldest organizations. It continues a

tradition of community bands which began before the town's incorporation in 1875.

Records indicate that the "Village Band" performed at the opening of the Provincial Normal School in 1855.

The band draws its membership from throughout the central Nova Scotia area, and contains musicians from a wide range of ages and levels of experience. Through the years, the band has benefited from the leadership of a succession of conductors including J. Arch Fraser, J. Chalmers Doane, Ron MacKay and Jack Sirulnikoff. The current Musical Director is Ken Henderson.

The band usually carries out a year-round schedule of appearances at community events in the Truro area including Remembrance Day Service, Festival of Lights, Santa Claus Parade and Canada Day celebrations.

They also appear at summer parades throughout the area , and present summer concerts at the J. Arch Fraser Memorial Bandshell in Victoria Park.

The band welcomes the enthusiastic participation of student musicians from the area high school bands, and of post-secondary students during its summer schedule. Membership is open to all interested wind and percussion players. Rehearsals are on Tuesdays at 7:30 at the Truro Public Library Building.

public school and community bands . She is currently the conductor of the Holland College Community Concert Band "the Welshmen", a role she has held since January 2015 and has been a music educator for more than 27 years. Most recently, Christine was director of the Cape Breton Community Bandfest in October 2021 and is now a Member at Large for the Nova Scotia Band Association. She has also adjudicated at festivals and provided clinics in Newfoundland and Labrador and Ontario. In her role as a music educator on Prince Edward Island, she has directed concert bands, jazz ensembles, and R&B bands at the intermediate and senior high school level. These groups have achieved great success at local music festivals and on performance tours to Montreal, Newfoundland, and most notably Cuba in 2011. In addition to directing ensembles, she has also contributed to music education on PEI by co-writing instrumental performance, vocal performance, popular music performance and the history of popular music curricula between the years 1998 -2019. Christine also initiated the development of the PEI Senior High Honors Band in 1999. Finally, Christine was awarded 2019 Music Educator of the Year by MusicPEI.
